Application Procedures

- 1. Application Form and Fee.** Please remit the completed application form and the \$75 application fee to the address below.
- 2. Autobiographical Statement.** This statement should capture one's personal mission with related specific life goals in relationship with God, relationship with people, financial health, physical health, and development for life work. It should include a synthesis of one's core values, spiritual gifts, personal passions, and life experiences.
- 3. References.** Deliver the enclosed Character Reference Form to three references—academic, pastoral, and personal—who can demonstrate evidence for your academic capacity for graduate study and personal maturity. Please include a stamped envelope addressed to the Graduate & Professional Studies Enrollment office with each Character Reference Form as a courtesy to each of your references.
- 4. Transcripts.**
 - A Baccalaureate degree of Arts or Science (or an equivalent degree) from a regionally accredited college or university, with a minimum 3.0 grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale, is required to qualify for admission to the program. An applicant whose cumulative GPA is below 3.0 may be considered for admission on academic probation.
 - Send a *Transcript Request Form* to all colleges or universities you have previously attended, requesting an official transcript of your record to be sent directly to Northwest University. Colleges charge a transcript request fee, so please enclose this to ensure timely processing.
 - A maximum of nine credits of coursework from an accredited graduate program may be transferred when the coursework directly applies to the program design.
- 5. Resumé or Curriculum Vitae.** Please submit your most recent version.
- 6. TOEFL.** International students whose native language is not English must submit a minimum score of 550 on the TOEFL Exam as part of the application process.
- 7. Interview.** Qualified applicants will be interviewed by College of Ministry faculty members and administrators, who will recommend admission, admission with conditions, or denial of admission, for decision by the director of the program.
