

Nelnet Payment Plan – Graduate

Northwest University offers payment plans through Nelnet Campus Commerce which allow you to pay your education expenses in smaller, more manageable monthly installments. Payment plans are not required but are available for those who would like to use a monthly plan to pay for their net balance owed after financial aid.

Nelnet Payment Plan – Graduate

To Enroll:

Students must enroll in the plan themselves and can add authorized parties after enrollment.

1. Log into your School (Eagle) Profile at <https://eagle.northwestu.edu/my-profile>.
2. On the “My Profile” page, select “Nelnet Payment Plan”.
3. On the Nelnet payment plan portal, sign in or create a new account.
4. Once you are signed in, on the Home tab you will see the different terms that are available. You can enroll in Fall, Spring, and Summer term payment plans. Select “Set up a Payment Plan” for the current or future term.
5. Welcome: Review the message and click “Begin”.
6. Contact Information: Review and click “Next”.
7. Amount Due: You will find additional information on the website for the “Amount Due” step. Enter “Tuition & Fees” and “Grants, Scholarships, & Loans”. Your payment plan should cover your estimated net balance owed for the term and can be adjusted (increased or decreased) after enrollment to include additional fees, changes in aid, etc. Click “Next”.
8. Payment Plan Options: Select the available “**Graduate (GRAD)**” payment plan that works for you. **Do not select an Online, NPP, or Traditional Undergraduate payment plan. If you enroll in a plan for the incorrect population, your payment plan will either be changed or cancelled, and the \$75 enrollment fee is nonrefundable.** Click “Next” and “OK”.
9. Payment Details: Select “Add Bank Account” and click “Next”. Credit cards are not accepted.
10. Add Account: Enter your bank information and click “Save”.
11. Payment Details: You will be charged the \$75 enrollment fee. Review the details and click “Next”.
12. Payment Schedule: Review and click “Next”.
13. Review & Authorize: Review the Terms and Conditions, then mark that you read the Term and Conditions. Click “Authorize”.
14. You are now done setting up your plan. Automatic payments will be paid directly to the payment plan. It is recommended to routinely log in and review your payment plan account.
15. If you would like Student Financial Services to be able to discuss your payment plan with another person, add the person as an Authorized Party in your account by clicking “Add an Authorized Party” on the Nelnet Home page.
