

## Veteran's Benefits Confirmation

### How do I know my VA eligibility?

To be eligible for VA Education Benefits, a student must first apply for the benefits online at <https://www.va.gov/>. Once they have applied, the student will receive either a denial letter or a Certificate of Eligibility (COE). The COE will outline a student's VA Entitlement and Program Eligibility. **An estimation of benefits may also be calculated online at <https://www.va.gov/gi-bill-comparison-tool>.** Additional helpful information can be found at <https://www.northwestu.edu/veterans>.

### The Student's Responsibility

- The student is responsible for turning in their Certificate of Eligibility (COE) to the NU VA Benefits Coordinator. NU will not know what the student is eligible for until the COE is received. Please see contact information below.
- The student is responsible for checking their NU Student Account to make sure that their balance is paid off each semester. Some VA Benefits cover all Tuition and Fees while others do not.
- The student is responsible for knowing their benefits and paying any out-of-pocket cost that is not covered by VA Benefits or Financial Aid from NU.
- The student is responsible for completing and turning in the Veteran's Benefits form to Student Financial Services.
