- 1) Have a strong liberal arts education from a regionally accredited college or university and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.30 in the last 90 quarter/60 semester credits. No grade below a "C" will be considered in this evaluation.
- 2) Review must be completed by designated personnel of the Northwest University School of Education (SOE). Review will consider the following:
 - a) A minimum of 24 semester/36 quarter credits that meet competencies is required.
 - b) At least one course must be completed in each discipline (multiple courses if noted below).
 - c) Courses maybe listed in more than one discipline, if appropriate, but credits will only be counted once.
 - d) If a course title does not specifically identify a content area, you may be asked to submit additional information, i.e. syllabus, course description, etc.
- 3) For unmet competencies, course work must be taken that meets requirement. Contact SOE Graduate Enrollment Counselor to verify that proposed course will meet the competency requirement.
