Official Transcript: All graduate program applicants are required to submit official transcripts from each college/university attended (other than Northwest University), showing completion of their bachelor's degree. Graduate program admissions requests a GPA of 2.70 or higher. Those with a lower GPA may apply by submitting an *Explanation of Grades* in a separate document. **Also, we do not require the submission of GRE scores for this degree program.** (Students still completing the bachelor's degree may apply by sending an unofficial transcript to elisa.anderson@northwestu.edu. An acceptance decision will be conditional pending the final official transcript.)

One Recommendation: Please be prepared to provide the contact information for a pastoral or professional reference within the application. The reference will be requested via the online application. The recommender may upload a letter of recommendation or complete the online evaluation form.

Essay: This autobiographical essay is a 500-750 word response fulfilling these requirements: a brief explanation of who you are, your educational background, God's call on your life, and why you are applying to the Northwest University College of Ministry Graduate Program.
